Ten Commandments of Moonlighting

- 1. Thou shalt not attempt to conceal thy freelance business from thy employer, for such is the path to the unemployment agency.
- 2. Thou shalt not use thy employer's computer, telephone, fax machine, photocopier, office supplies, or email account in connection with thy freelance business.
- 3. Thou shalt recognize thy personal limitations and accept only those jobs that thou canst realistically expect to finish on schedule. Moonlighters do not index 1000 page books in a week.
- 4. Thou shalt not miss deadlines of either thy employer or thy clients. Remember which job pays the mortgage and schedule indexing jobs accordingly.
- 5. Thou shalt not accept any indexing job that presents a conflict of interest with thy employer's business.
- 6. Thou shalt comply with all local and state rules for small business operation and shalt maintain records sufficient to satisfy the IRS, keeping thy business and personal finances separate.
- 7. Thou shalt network with other indexers and become active in ASI and other professional associations; for such is the sources of referrals.
- 8. Thou shalt schedule time with thy family and friends and recognize that an indexing lull is a treasure to be prized for marketing, recreation, or sleep.
- 9. Thou shalt regard dust bunnies as pets.
- 10. Thou shalt know when to say "NO!"
